**Notice of Application
and
Notice of Written Hearing
Electricity Generation Licence – UMH Energy Partnership
EB-2009-0291**

UMH Energy Partnership (“UMH”) has applied to the Ontario Energy Board for an electricity generation licence. The granting of this licence would enable the applicant to generate electricity in Ontario.

The application includes the following three water generation facilities:

1. Hound Chute Generating Station with an installed capacity of 9.5 MW located in the Township of Latchford and District of Timiskaming, Ontario.
2. Sandy Falls Generating Station with an installed capacity of 5.5 MW and is located in the City of Timmins, Ontario.
3. Lower Sturgeon Generating Station with an installed capacity of 14 MW and is located in Mahaffy Township, Ontario.

The facilities noted above are currently inactive and are currently identified on Ontario Power Generation’s (“OPG”) electricity generation licence (EG-2003-0104). The subject facilities are planned for re-development and will be placed into service by Quarter 4, 2010. OPG has filed a related application for a licence amendment (EB-2009-0319) to remove the subject facilities from its licence should the Board approve the licence application for UMH.

The application will be decided by an employee of the Board who has been delegated this authority pursuant to section 6 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*. The employee does not intend to provide for an award of costs when deciding this application.

How to participate in the hearing

The application will be decided by way of written hearing unless a party satisfies the Board that there is good reason for holding an oral hearing. If you object to a written hearing for this application, you must provide written reasons why an oral hearing is necessary. Any submissions objecting to a written hearing must be received by the Board and copied to the applicant by September 10, 2009.

If you wish to participate in a written hearing, you must forward three paper copies, and if possible, an electronic copy in Word format and searchable PDF format, of your written submission to the Board and one copy to the applicant. All submissions must be received by September 14, 2009. If the applicant wishes to respond to the written submissions, such response must be filed with the Board and copied to any party that made submissions by September 21, 2009.

All submissions must quote file number EB-2009-0291, and clearly state the sender’s name, postal address, telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.

Information relating to the application is available for viewing at the Board’s offices at the address provided below or by contacting the applicant. The address and contact information for the applicant are also provided below.
